The supply box marked "Boutonnieres" in the band closet had left over flowers from previous years that covered the rest of the boutonnieres that we needed to make. *It would not have been cost effective to buy them individually.*

I assembled them at home. Cheryl Costantino came over and helped the night before the event.

Supplies:

2 boxes of flowers @ 13.89 each

8 rolls of floral tape at 1.49 each

17 rolls of ribbon from Joann's at various sale and coupon prices along with pins and a roll of wire totaling \$34.63

Boutonnieres

This year, red silk rose balls were purchased from Amazon. (Ask decorating committee what colors they are using.)

I assembled them at home. It took about 8 hours to make 216 boutonnieres. (202 students, 10 extra and 4 boutonnieres for the chair and teachers.) The chairs and teacher boutonnieres had coordinating bows.

I contacted the volunteers about a week prior to the event and we met in the back hallway between the gym and cafeteria about 15 minutes prior to the first student arrival. We split into two groups, one group in the cafeteria and one in the back hall. The students seemed to be easier to catch in the cafeteria.

The pinning lasted until just after the beginning of the concert. Ask Mr. Cleveland to remind students to have the boutonnieres pinned upon arrival.

List of Supplies:

3 - 9.84 Inch Rose balls	\$43.17 (\$14.39 each)
2 boxes – 2 inch corsage pins, 144 count	
& Floral tape (2 rolls)	\$ 8.46
Ribbon & wire (22 gauge)	\$ 3.17
Total:	\$54.80 (about 26 cents each)

How to make: Cut wire approximately 5 inches. Wrap around stem, under leaf and back around. Leave approximately 1 inch stem. Wrap with florist tape. Ask Mr. Cleveland for box of supplies.

Boutonnieres

This year, white silk rose balls were purchased from Nordlie Wholesale, as a favor from the previous chair, Chris Coderre. Chris and I assembled them at my home. It took about 4 hours to make 208 boutonnieres for the students and 5 boutonnieres for the chairs and teachers.

I contacted the volunteers about a week before the event and we met in the back hallway between the gym and cafeteria at 6:15, 15 minutes prior to the first students arrival. We split into two groups, some in the back hallway near the gym and the other in the cafeteria to catch the students coming in the cafeteria doors.

The pinning last until about 8:15, with a few late arrivals. Remember to ask Mr. Cleveland to remind students to have their boutonnieres pinned upon arrival.
